2430 CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Purpose of Policy: The Board of Education organizes its Policy Manual in order that users can easily locate the policies and regulations.

The North Haledon Board of Education believes that the educational goals of the district are best achieved by a diversity of learning experiences, some of which are more appropriately conducted outside the regular program/curriculums taught in the classrooms of each school.

All learning experiences offered by the schools of this district – curricular and extracurricular – should be planned and integrated toward the attainment of the Board’s objectives.

For purposes of this policy, “extracurricular activities” shall be those activities which are sponsored by the Board of Education but are not offered for credit toward graduation. Such activities (a) shall ordinarily be conducted wholly, or partly, outside the regular school day, (b) shall be marked by pupil participation in the processes of their initiation, planning, organization, and execution, and (c) shall be made available to all pupils who voluntarily elect to participate in them.

The Board shall make school facilities and grounds, supplies, and equipment available and assign staff members for the support of a program of extracurricular activities for pupils in grades five through eight.

No extracurricular activity shall be considered to be under the sponsorship of this Board unless it has been approved by the Board on recommendation of the Superintendent. All extracurricular programs and their operation shall comply with district affirmative action requirements.
