2520 INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES

Purpose of Policy: The Board of Education organizes its Policy Manual in order that users can easily locate the policies and regulations.

The Board of Education shall provide each teaching staff member with the supplies, materials, and equipment necessary for the implementation of the approved instructional program and each pupil with the supplies and materials required for the successful completion of a given course of study (curriculum).

Exceptions to this policy shall be:

1. Where individualized and non-reusable clothing or equipment is required for reasons of safety, health, or the protection of school property, pupils will be requested to provide their own clothing or equipment which shall meet standards set by the school. Such standards shall be those reasonably related to the considerations of safety, health, and protection of property.
2. Where pupils prepare useful items which they are permitted to keep, they shall pay the district the cost of the materials used.
3. The Board may require that pupils provide certain supplies for the conduct of co-curricular activities.
4. Where the foregoing requirement(s) imposes a financial hardship on a pupil, the Board will assume the cost. The Superintendent shall devise procedures assuring that no pupil need be denied participation in the school program for financial reasons, while at the same time guarding the privacy of each pupil.
