

5440 HONORING STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Purpose of Regulation: The Board of Education recognizes the need for Policies and Regulations that support the policies, in order to effectively govern the School.

A. Honor Rolls

Principal's High Honor Roll

A student having all A's (90% and higher), along with O's and S's on their report card during a given marking period will be placed on the Principal's High Honor Roll. However, if a student receives an N in either Art or Music, and/or a number 12 or 13 in the areas needing improvement related to school conduct, then that student will not be eligible for inclusion on the High Honor Roll.

Principal's Honor Roll

A student having all A's, B's (80% and higher), O's and S's on their report card during a given marking period will be placed on the Principal's Honor Roll. However, if a student receives an N in either Art or Music, and/or a number 12 or 13 in the areas needing improvement related to school conduct, then that student will not be eligible for inclusion on the Principal's Honor Roll.

B. Additional Recognitions

Because it is not possible to anticipate the achievements of students in all areas of school and community life, all teaching staff members are directed to be alert to the outstanding accomplishments of students other than those listed in this regulation. Any such accomplishment should be reported to the Superintendent with a recommendation that the Board consider appropriate recognition of the student.
