

### 2464 GIFTED AND TALENTED STUDENTS

Purpose of Regulation: The Board of Education recognizes the need for Policies and Regulations that support the policies, in order to effectively govern the School.

The person, or persons, hired to coordinate the North Haledon Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program shall be responsible for accomplishing the following tasks during the first and second program sessions each school year:

- Establishment, or revision, of the sets of multiple criteria for the selection of students to be included in the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program for grades one through two, grades three through four, and grades five through eight.
- Development of course offerings/descriptions and course start and end dates for each session, along with assurances that the content of the proposed course offerings is aligned with the relevant New Jersey Core Curriculum Content Standards.
- Assisting the Superintendent in his/her efforts to seek out and recommend for hire qualified individuals to teach one, or more, of the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program courses offered during the first session and the second session.
- Formulation of a list of the names of the students who have been selected for inclusion in the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program for grades one through two, grades three through four, and grades five through eight.\*
- Submission of the three sets of multiple selection criteria, the course offerings/descriptions, the course start and end dates, the course instructors' names, and the anticipated number of pupils in attendance to the Superintendent of Schools for his/her approval on, or about, November for the first session, and on, or about, February for the second session.\*\*
- Presentation by the Superintendent of the sets of multiple selection criteria, the course offerings/descriptions, the course start and end dates, and the course instructors' names to the Board on, or about, November for the first session, and on, or about, February for the second session.
- Presentation to the Board on, or about, the May Board meeting regarding (a) the number of students, by grade level, who participated in the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program during the first and second sessions and (b) feedback obtained from students and/or parent(s) or legal guardian(s) regarding their degree of perceived satisfaction with the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program courses offered during the current school year.

\*Students who have been selected for inclusion in the Enrichment/Gifted and Talented Program shall be notified by the program coordinator(s) about their acceptance into the program, and the course offerings that are being made available to them, only after each course offering, and a qualified instructor to teach each course offering, have been approved first by the Superintendent of Schools and the North Haledon Board of Education.

\*\*Additionally, at the conclusion of the first session and the second session, the program coordinator(s) shall complete a supply requisition form for submission to the Business office that lists each instructor and the number of hours worked by each instructor.
