# New Jersey's Statewide Assessment

- ▶ This 2019 – Spring Administration
- ▶ NJSLA-ELA – Number of units were reduced from three to two, while there was a reduction in the number of units and test items, students were assessed on the major claims of reading and writing and all subclaims. (Grade 3- 75 minutes each unit and Grade 4-8 was 90 minutes each unit)
- ▶ NJSLA- Math- Grades 3-5 were reduced from four to three units. Grades 6-8 remained at three units, but the time was reduced by 20 minutes and the number of test questions were reduced. (Grades 3-8 was 60 minutes each unit)
- ▶ Algebra I- the test was reduced from three units to two units – 90 minutes each unit.
- ▶ North Haledon - Grade 3-8 ELA & Grades 3-8 Math, Algebra 1

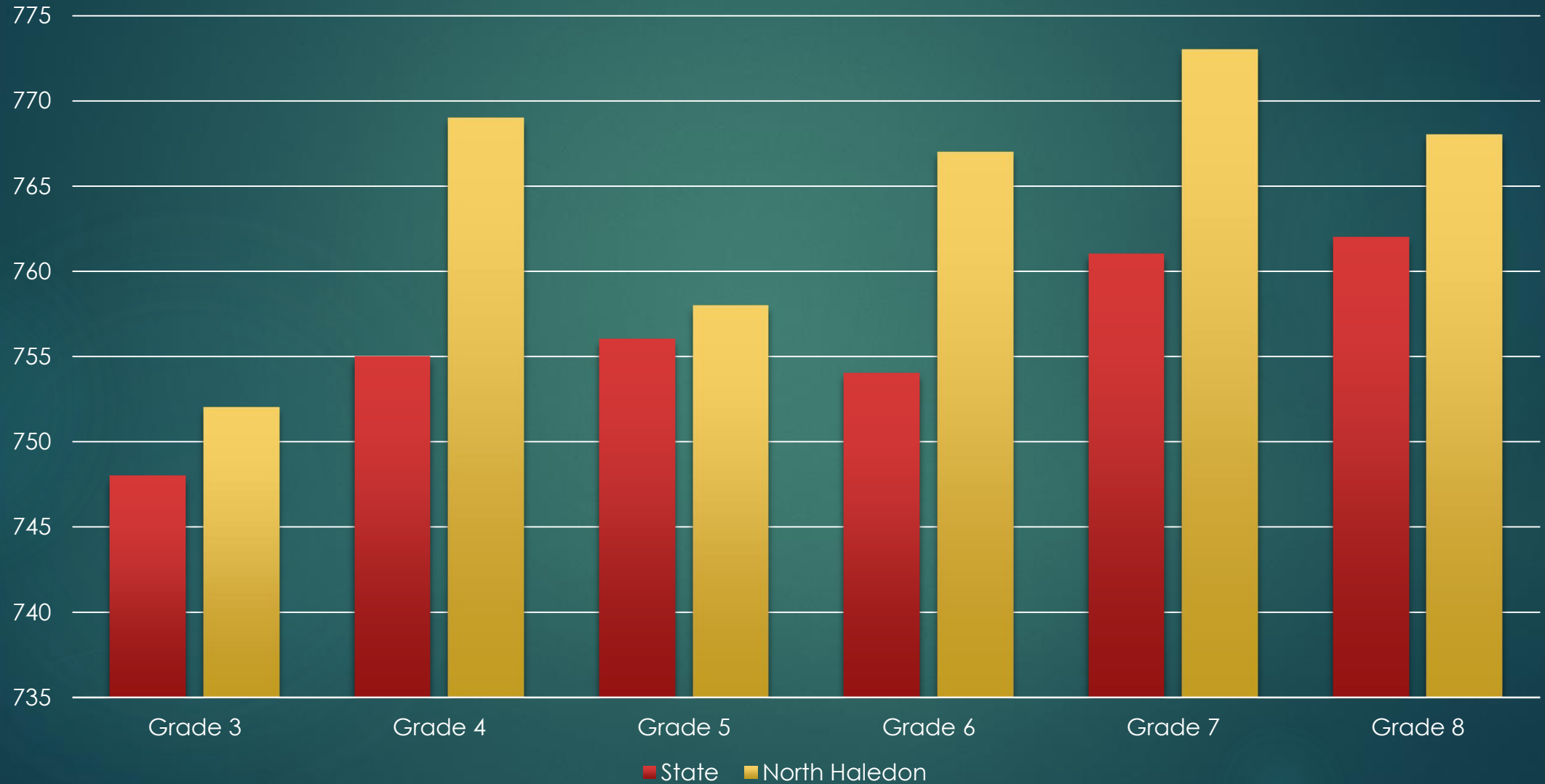
# NJSLA Performance Levels

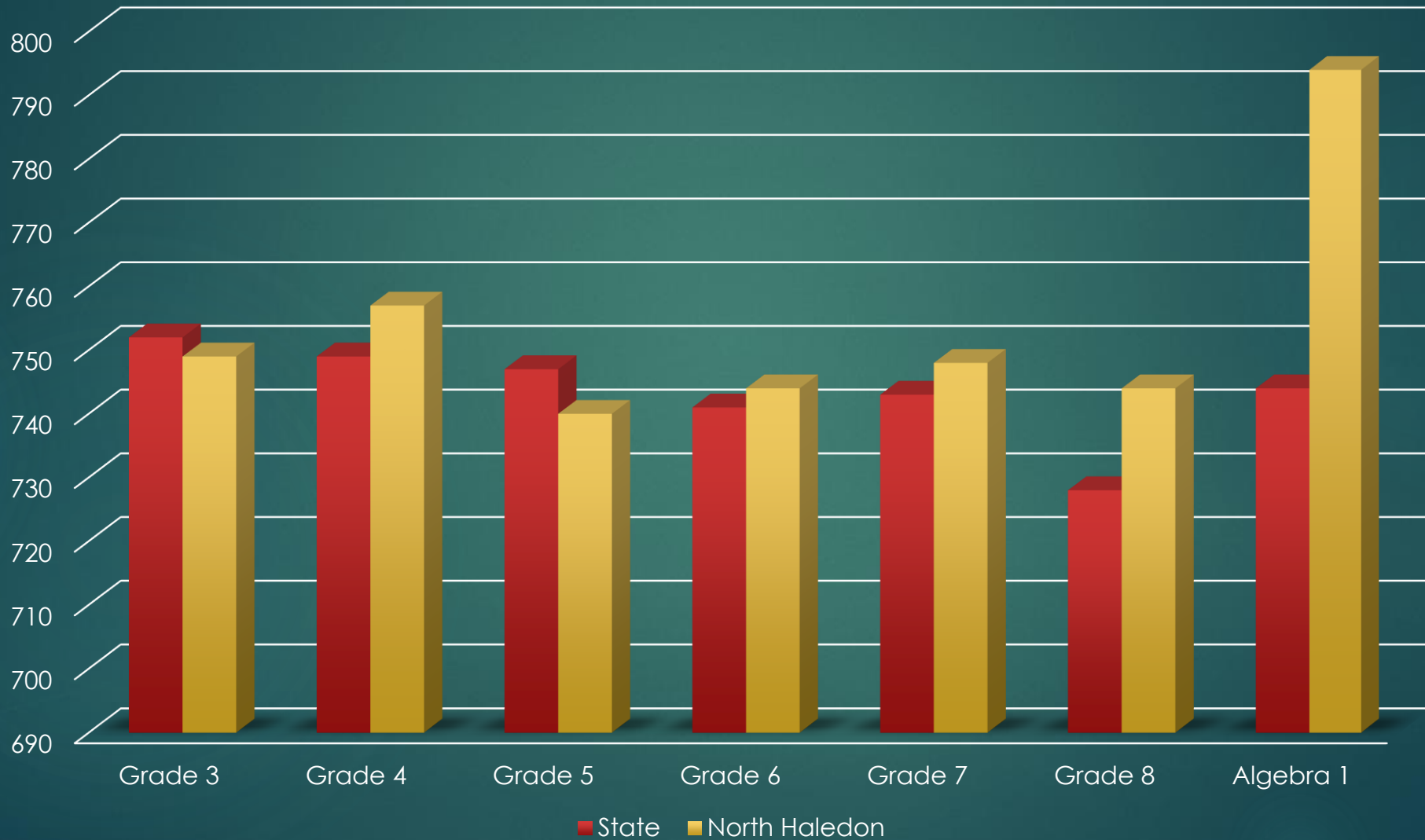

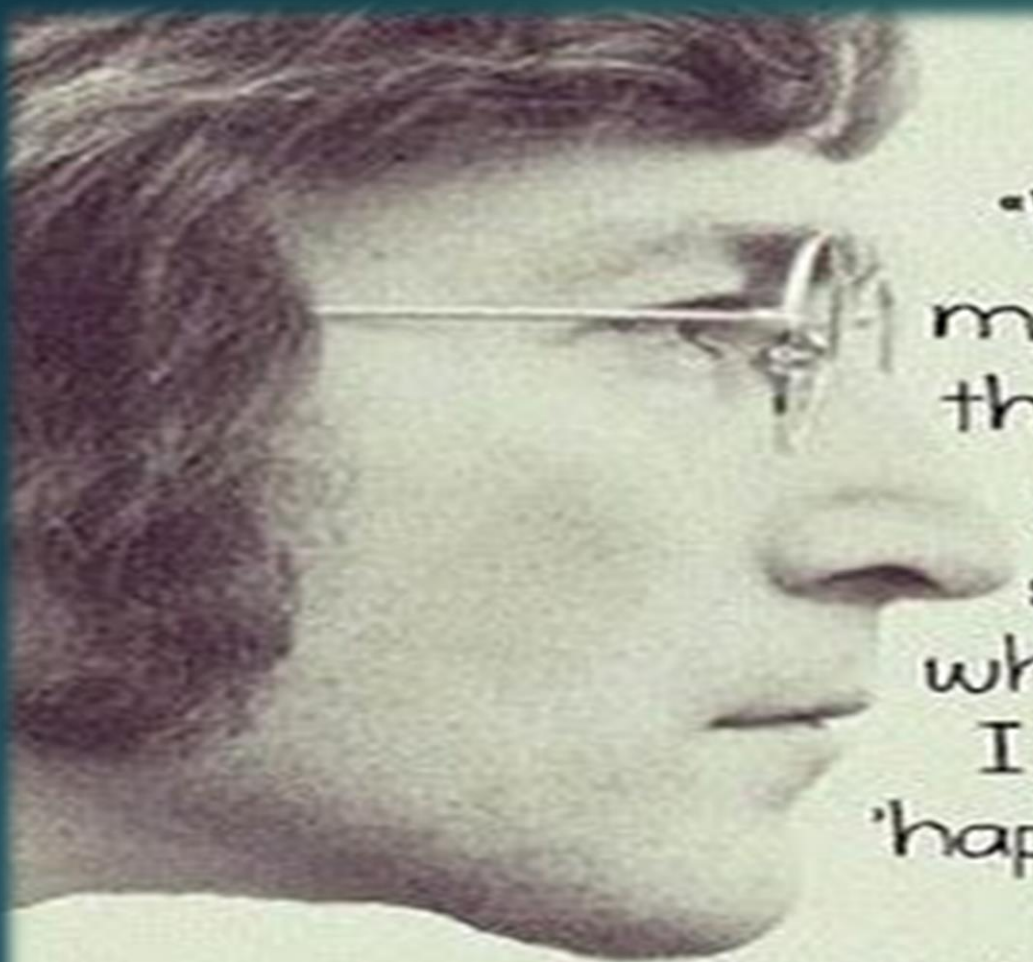
